Habitual Sin

Cherished Sin? Often, a love/hate relationship. (Rom 7:15-25)

Habitual sin impacts our intimacy with God. We must make a choice to SEEK HIM and SURRENDER.

Who Can Stand in God's Presence?

When we approach God and experience his holiness, we become aware of our own sin.

Isaiah 6:5 And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

Clean Hands and a Pure Heart

Our hands and heart represent our actions and our thoughts.
