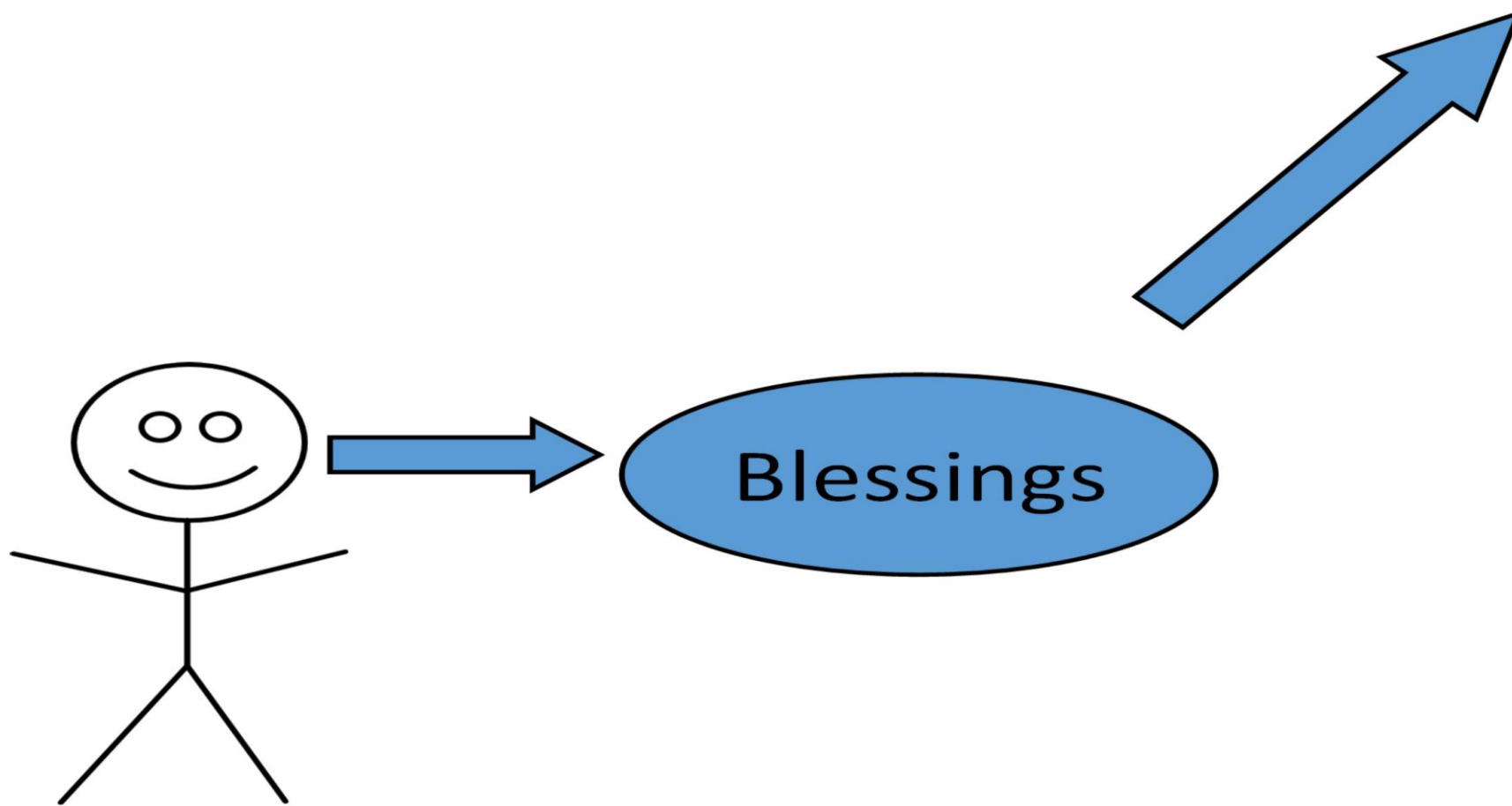
Thanksgiving

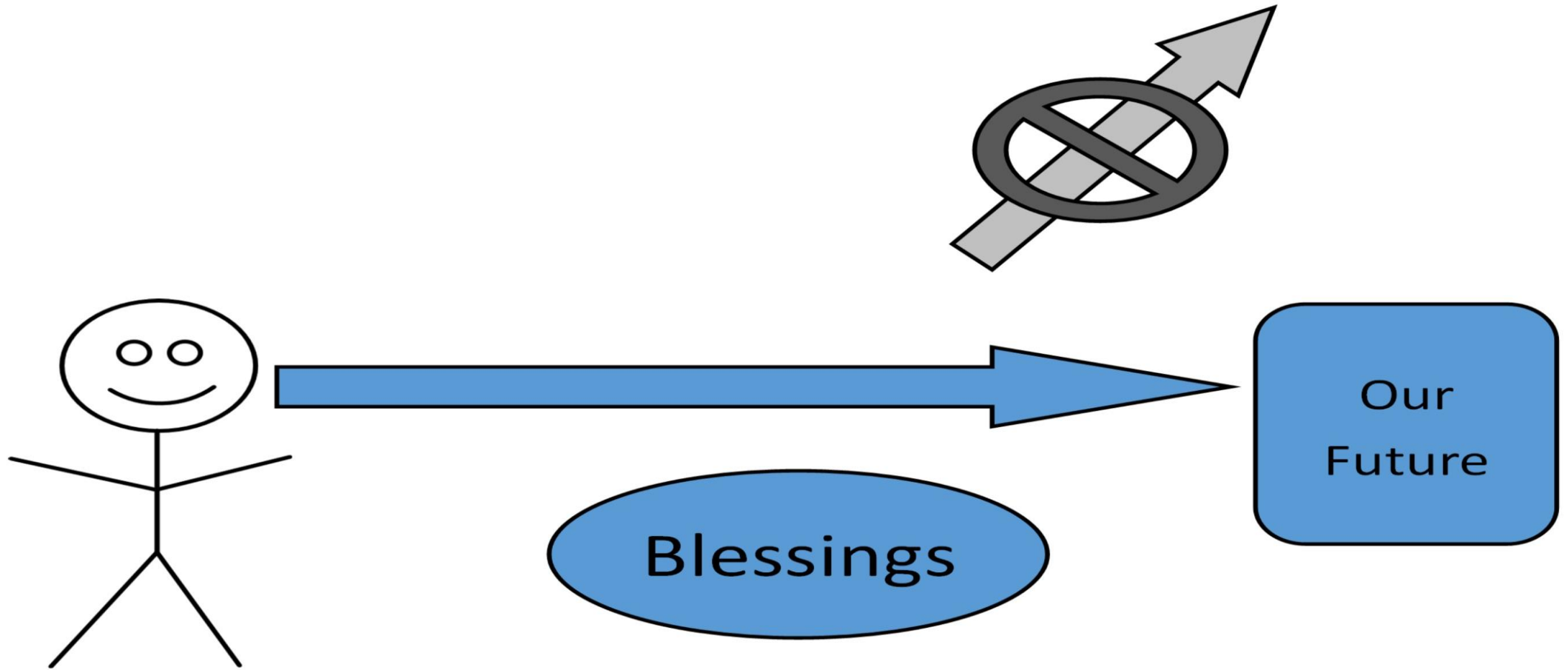
Contentment

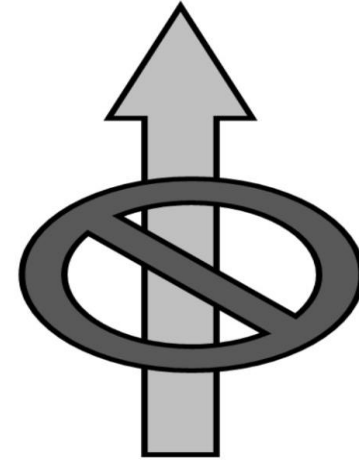

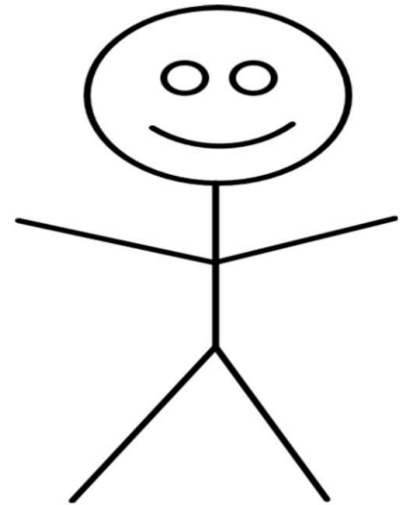

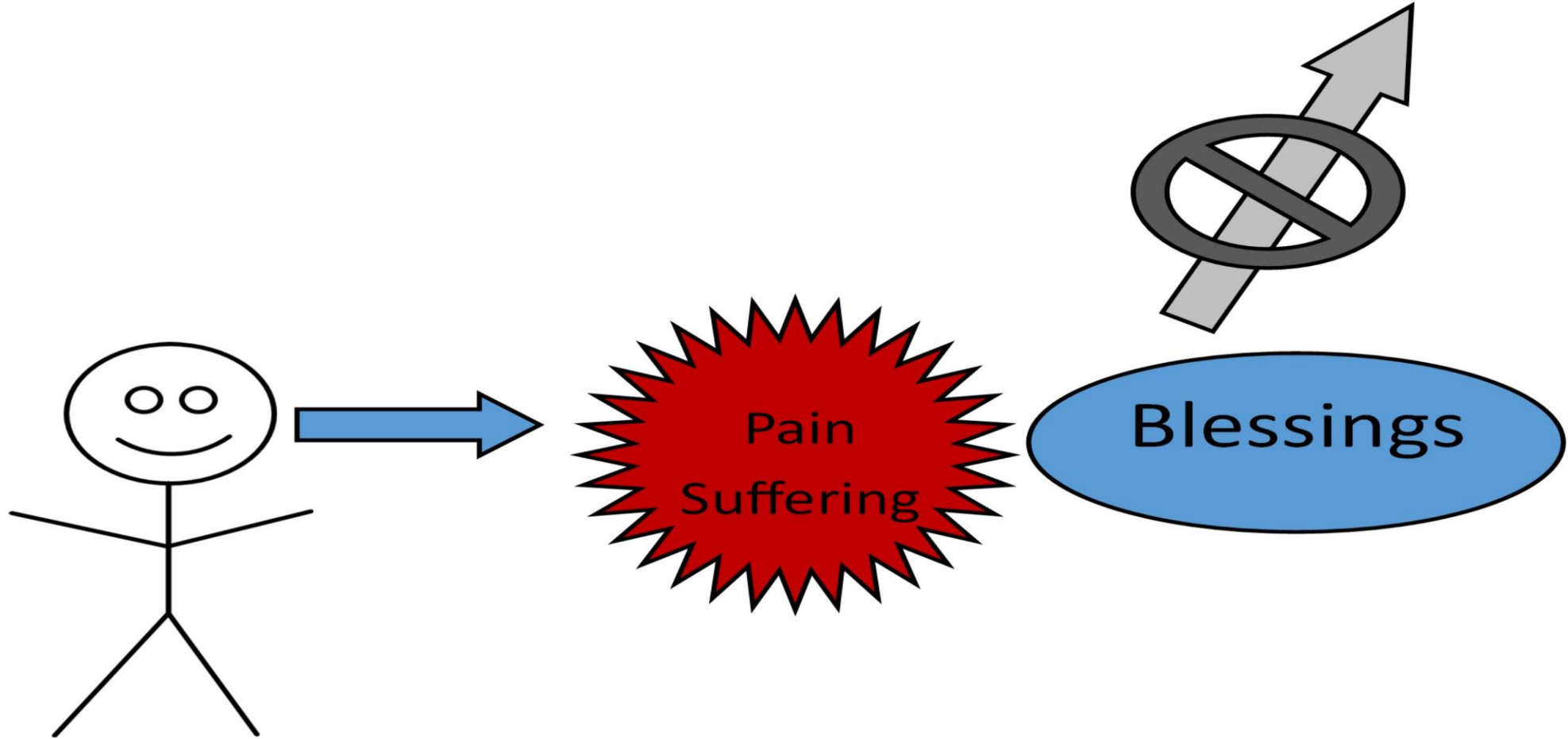


Contentment
